

Soft White

➔ Overview

Soft White is made from the Niagara grape, a native American white wine grape variety that has been planted and enjoyed as a semi-sweet wine since the mid 1800s. It is widely grown and thrives in cooler climates such as New York, Washington, Pennsylvania, Michigan and Canada. Noted for its handsome, showy appearance, these grapes are also characterized by their pleasant aroma and intense, fresh grape flavor.

➔ Tasting Notes

This semi-sweet wine is luscious and tastes like freshly picked grapes. Remarkable rich and flowery bouquet. Familiar grape flavor that has a long, smooth and satisfying finish.

➔ Winemaking

Niagara juice from the cool growing regions of the Great Lakes is fermented in stainless steel tanks. Cold fermentation emphasizes Niagara's unique flavor and aroma. Fermentation is arrested by chilling wine to retain natural sweetness.

➔ Food Pairing

Serve chilled. White is excellent accompanied by fresh fruit or rich almond cake. Delightful when paired with poultry or pork dishes. Perfect with light cheeses such as fontina and farmer's cheese.



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
